Treasurer's Report: The balance in the regular bank account is \$4,158.66. The balance

Brubaker Run: Mr. Stern and the representatives from the Army Corp of Engineers said it would cost \$4.2 million for a treatment system for Brubaker Run and \$12,000 per month for maintenance. We will Try to get local people to do the contract work.

A field visit was made by DEP personnel: Joe Allison, Ray Rodgers, and Tom Holencick and association members: Art Rose, Bob Funicelli, and Earl Smithmyer. It was determined That four new sampling sites were needed along with the existing Sites. DEP is to pay the lab fees for the samples.

Membership Committee: There were 26 new members at the skeet shoot. A

Tech. Committee: We are sampling at 37 sites. We are to put in for a Grower Greener grant to do the sampling on the gob piles.

New Business:

Dysart Sportsman's Dam: All permits have been secured for the draining and Dredging. We need a price quote for the dredging. Brian Rabish is to write a WPCAMR grant to see if We can get money to help pay for the work. Mark Hartel of the Fish and Boat Commission indicated That we cannot drain the dam until June 15, 2003 due to Wild trout in the stream.

Web Site: Sean Bartlett made a motion seconded by Jen that we Get a credit card with a \$500.00 maximum to be used for Web site and other purchases. All purchases to be pre-Approved by the association.

Public Relations: No report.

Rob Piper discussed getting grant money for the disposal of tires and illegal trash from dump sites. Penn Dot will not take the trash.
